

Last day of planning for the Lovers Film Festival

(Turin, October 25th, Cinema Massimo, National Cinema Museum)

This Sunday, October 25th, the planning of the Lovers Film Festival comes to an end at Cinema Massimo, in Turin. You can buy the tickets only online on the festival website.

The day will culminate with the *Closing Night* at 20:15 pm, in Cabiria room during which Achille Lauro will be the protagonist of a remote talk with Vladimir Luxuria. It can be followed by the public in the room and then on delay on the festival channels.

"In accordance with the new safety measures for Covid 19 and in order to discourage the mobility between regions, I decided to participate in the night event 'Conversazioni maleducate', an interview with the artistic director Vladimir Luxuria, remotely, in connection from home" comments **Achille Lauro**.

Also the politician and LGBT activist **Alessandro Zan** will attend the night event, during which the winners of the festival will be announced. With the director, he will address the theme of the draft law against homophobia and the misogyny of which he is the speaker and that, barring accidents, will be discussed in the meeting room on October 27th.

The Closing Night will be opened by the musical showcase performed by **Le Kikies**, accompanied by Savio Monachella on the drums and by Gianluca Gallucci on the bass, to delight and persuade the public with a musical show that will enjoy the great classics of pop in an unique version.

At the end, the showing of **Douze Points** by Daniel Syrkin (Israel/France 2019): a film in equilibrium between comedy, thriller and the satire movie that tells an unique relationship between two young Muslim boys during the most colorful song contest ever imaginable.
