38th Lovers, the oldest LGBTQI+ festival in Europe and third in the world directed by Vladimir Luxuria

(Turin, Cinema Massimo – National Museum of Cinema)

THE PROGRAM OF WEDNESDAY, APRIL 19th

Wednesday, April 19th, starts the thirty-eighth edition of the Lovers Film Festival, the oldest festival on LGBTQI+ (lesbian, gay, bisexual, trans, queer and intersex issues) directed by Vladimir Luxuria and founded by Giovanni Minerba and Ottavio Ma, which takes place from 18 to 23 April 2023 at the Cinema Massimo, the multiplex of the National Museum of Cinema in Turin.

Many special guests in Turin:

At 9.30 am at the Cinema Massimo, the scientific communicator and influencer Vincenzo Schettini will be the protagonist of the talk La fisica che ci piace for high schools, that will precede the screening of Le Paradis by Zeno Graton (France 2023). The appointment is included in the calendar of La Scuola in prima Fila - a project of the National Museum of Cinema realized as part of the National Plan of Cinema and Images for the School promoted by the Ministry of Culture and the Ministry of Education and Merit.

Prominent international presence: **Kodo Nishimura** (6 pm), a **Buddhist monk from Tokyo** who began his career working as a *makeup artist* in the United States and collaborating on important events such as Miss Universe and NY Fashion Week. In 2015 he completed the path to become a Buddhist monk and achieved notoriety by participating in the television program Queer Eye: We're in Japan.

As an **activist for the rights of the LGBTQI+ community** he has spoken at the United Nations, Yale and Stanford Universities, sparking the interest of the international press (CNN, BBC, ABC and Vogue Magazine). At Lovers, Wednesday 19th at 6 pm, will officially present his





latest book released in Italy and will explain his mission: to encourage and enrich others inwardly through Buddhist wisdom. And a little bit of makeup.

At 7.30 pm will be guest of the Lovers the famous face of many successful fiction **Giancarlo Commare** who this year is in the cast of the TV series Sky Original Romulus 2, of Qui non è Hollywood on Disney + in the film Nuovo Olimpo, directed by Ferzan Özpetek and the actor **Piero Di Blasio** protagonist of many shows including the musical Alta Società with Vanessa Incontrada. **Commare**, as the protagonist, and **Di Blasio**, as director, will debut on April 26th at the Teatro Colosseo in Turin with the musical **Tutti parlano di Jamie** based on a true story and iinspired by the BBC documentary entitled Jamie: Drag Queen at 16.

Novelist Stéphane Belcourt has agreed to sponsor the bicentenary of a famous cognac: it's the perfect opportunity to go back in time to where he grew up. After meeting Lucas, the





son of his first love, he will have to relive a fundamental part of his life. He will be overcome by a stream of memories: an uncontrollable desire, bodies that come together, a passion that must be silenced. And this is because when they were 17 they couldn't express their love for each other. Inspired by Philippe Bresson's masterpiece, *Lie with me*, a heart-breaking tale of a painful past, where memory recalls a long-lost youth.

Artur invites some friends to his luxurious villa for Christmas. Their days go by swimming, sunbathing, with jokes, games, drugs and alcohol. There is a lot of companionship, but the joyful camaraderie is often tinged with an oppressive machismo: gratuitous comments, homophobic jokes... and a feeling of something more. Something they can't fully accept and that must be kept hidden. Marco Berger is back, after the movie Taekwondo (2016). Through his unashamed voyeurism and keen gaze, he describes the interactions of a group of allegedly straight men, often problematic and unresolved.

Patricia Highsmith is considered the queen of the thriller. Some of the greatest masterpieces of classic and contemporary cinema such as *Strangers on a Train* (1951) by Alfred Hitchcock, *The Talented Mr. Ripley* (1999) by Anthony Minghella and *Carol* (2015) by Todd Haynes were based on or inspired by her novels. Thanks to the result of a vast amount of research into archives, diaries as well as interviews, Loving Highsmith is an intimate and engaging portrait of both the writer and the person.

Midnight Cowboy was the first R-rated movie to win an Oscar, thus ushering in the New Hollywood Era. An absolute cult film, portraying the lives of the aspiring gigolo Jon Voight and conman Dustin Hoffman, who move against the background of a nocturnal and desperate New York. The must-see documentary explores the history behind this dark and difficult masterpiece to describe a revolutionary time, when a brand-new generation of filmmakers tore up the outdated rules of the Dream Factory with the help of brave, unique movies.
