One night in his near-empty tower block in contemporary London, Adam (Andrew Scott) has a chance encounter with a mysterious neighbor Harry (Paul Mescal), which punctures the rhythm of his everyday life. As a relationship develops between them, Adam is preoccupied with memories of the past and finds himself drawn back to the suburban town where he grew up, and the childhood home where his parents (Claire Foy and Jamie Bell), appear to be living, just as they were on the day they died, 30 years before.

Searchlight Pictures presents, in Association with Film4 and TSG Entertainment, a Blueprint Pictures Production, *All of Us Strangers*, produced by Graham Broadbent, Pete Czernin, Sarah Harvey. Written and directed by Andrew Haigh and starring Andrew Scott, Paul Mescal, with Jamie Bell and Claire Foy, the film is based on the novel "Strangers" by Taichi Yamada (published in Italy by Casa editrice Nord), novel that was awarded with the prestigious Yamamoto Shugoro Prize for Literature. Taichi Yamada (1934-2023) was one of the most famous and highly regarded contemporary Japanese writers, called by Bret Easton Ellis "one of the best Japanese authors I have ever read".

Cinematography is by Jamie D. Ramsay, SASC, with production design by Sarah Finlay, costume design by Sarah Blenkinsop, hair and make-up by Zoe Clare Brown. The editor is Jonathan Alberts, ACE, with the music by Emilie Levienaise-Farrouch.
